Mobilization

The APERe ensures the meeting of stakeholders on the theme of the energy transition through the coordination of the various programs:

- > POLLEC, that guides Walloon municipalities for the elaboration of action plans as part of their commitment to the Covenant of Mayors. 200 municipalities are leaders of initiatives for the energy future.
- > TEPOS: 47 Belgian municipalities committed to becoming positive energy territories are supported by the APERe

Actions

The actions of the APERe are organized around 4 axes:

- Territories: support for communities that are committed to the energy transition (action plan, long-term vision, etc.)
- Cooperatives: dissemination of good practices, crowdfunding activities
- Prosumers: awareness-raising, financial simulator, support for solar PV investments
- Observatory: diffusion of energy figures in Belgium
